








A Lift for Independence: How the Foundation Helped Scott Thrive

Scott is a person who refuses to let challenges define him. Born with cerebral palsy, he has always used a wheelchair for mobility, but his spirit has never been confined by his circumstances. Scott's positive attitude, humor, and infectious smile make him a friend to everyone he meets.

Recently, Scott faced a series of health setbacks that affected his mobility and led to multiple hospital stays. During one of our conversations, he shared that his overhead lift—vital for transferring from his bed to his wheelchair—was no longer working properly. The lift's inconsistencies made him anxious about using it, as there was a real risk of getting stuck. Without the lift, Scott had to rely on multiple people to help him move, making it difficult to keep appointments and maintain his independence.

It is thanks to your support that we can continue making a difference in the lives of people like Scott.





We explored the possibility of repairing the lift, but the aging motor needed to be replaced entirely—a costly expense not covered by insurance. The financial burden was too great for Scott and his family, but he still needed a safe way to get out of bed and attend his appointments. After discussing the situation with her supervisor, Shauna, Heather reached out to the Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation for assistance. Thanks to the collaboration between Shauna, the Foundation, and Scott's care team, we were able to secure a new lift for him.

The relief this brought to Scott and his family was immense. With the new lift in place, Scott can now safely transfer to his wheelchair, regain some independence, and take the first steps toward getting back to his active self.

Heather, Scott's physical therapist, expressed her deep gratitude for having resources like the Charitable Foundation to turn to for patients in need. She emphasized that the Foundation is a true lifeline, helping to bridge the gap between what insurance covers and what patients need to live their best lives. It is thanks to your support that we can continue making a difference in the lives of people like Scott.





Beyond Medical Care: How the Charitable Foundation Enhanced Niveen's Life

One of the most rewarding aspects of being a pediatric physical therapist at Nascentia Health is working with children and families from diverse countries and cultures. Catherine, one of our dedicated pediatric physical therapists, plays an essential role in helping these children obtain medical equipment covered by insurance to enhance their mobility, safety, and comfort. However, there are many crucial items that insurance does not cover, yet are vital for improving the quality of life for these children and their families, who often cannot afford them. Niveen is one of those children.

Niveen is a 9-year-old girl with cerebral palsy who came to the United States as a refugee with her parents and three siblings. Catherine worked closely with Niveen and assisted her in obtaining essential medical equipment approved by her insurance, such as a wheelchair and a bath chair. During one visit, Niveen's mother mentioned that she was feeding her on the hard wooden floor. Recognizing the need for a better solution, Catherine reached out to the Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation. Thanks to their support, the Foundation was able to provide a soft floor mat, a pillow for neck support, and a positioning cushion to make feeding Niveen more comfortable and supportive.

In addition to the feeding situation, Niveen's parents expressed concerns about her poor sleep. She was sleeping on a twin-sized bed with a very thin mattress on a metal frame, which increased her risk of developing skin breakdown. Once again, Catherine contacted the Charitable Foundation, and they stepped in to help. The Foundation provided a thicker, more supportive mattress to help relieve pressure and improve Niveen's sleep quality. Along with the mattress, they also supplied new pillows and bedding. Seeing Niveen's bright smile when the new mattress and bedding arrived was an incredibly heartwarming moment.

The Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation is a wonderful resource that provides funding for essential items not covered by insurance—items that can significantly enhance the lives of medically fragile children. Catherine and the entire care team are deeply grateful for the Foundation and all it does to support our patients and their families.

A Holiday Gift from the Foundation

The Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation was proud to select five families from our pediatric program to receive gifts this holiday season. One of these recipients was Nazarian, a resilient two-yearold who has faced significant challenges since birth, including being born prematurely and experiencing developmental delays.

Nazarian is lovingly cared for by his father and two uncles, who work tirelessly to provide him with around-the-clock support. Recognizing the family's dedication and the challenges they face, the Foundation, in collaboration with Kara, a dedicated speech language pathologist, stepped in to make a meaningful difference in Nazarian's life. Kara shared, "The therapy equipment and toys provided by the Foundation have had a direct and positive impact on his progress and development."

Through Kara's frequent visits and the Foundation's support, Nazarian now has a safe, child-friendly environment that includes essential items like new bottles, food, toys, books, blankets, and a crawl pad. Kara has become an invaluable part of Nazarian's support system, helping to create a nurturing 'village' around him. The Foundation is honored to be part of this journey, providing Nazarian and his family with the resources they need to thrive.
