SUPPORTING GROWTH, ONE MEAL AT A TIME

For Garret, something as simple as sitting safely for a meal was once a significant challenge. Because he is unable to hold his head up or sit independently, mealtime required constant vigilance and presented real safety concerns for his family. Without proper support, everyday moments carried unnecessary risk.

Through the Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation, Garret's clinician, Kara, was able to secure a specialized highchair designed with a reclining seat and safety harness to support his unique needs. She personally assembled the chair upon delivery, ensuring it was ready for immediate use and properly fitted for Garret's comfort and safety.

Since receiving the chair, Garret has been able to participate safely and comfortably in mealtime, turning moments of risk into moments of connection. As he grows stronger, the adaptive chair will continue to support his development providing lasting benefit and peace of mind for his family.



RESTORING INDEPENDENCE THROUGH SAFE MOVEMENT

For Stacy, everyday movements became a serious challenge following spinal fractures and a complex medical history. She was unable to safely transfer herself, and traditional caregiver-assisted lifting caused pain and risked further injury. Without the right equipment, routine activities like moving from a chair, using the bathroom, or getting into a car were unsafe and exhausting.

When insurance would not cover a Turner Pro Transfer Aid, the Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation stepped in. With this specialized device, Stacy can now transfer safely between the toilet, chair, and car, dramatically reducing the risk of injury for both her and her caregiver. More than improving safety, the transfer aid has restored dignity, confidence, and greater independence to her daily life.

SEEING POSSIBILITY AGAIN

At just 44 years old, Kyle is legally blind and managing multiple complex health conditions that make everyday tasks difficult. Reading appointment details, tracking his daily schedule, and navigating independently posed constant challenges, creating barriers not only to independence, but to accessing the care he needs.

When financial hardship and lack of insurance coverage made Meta Smart Glasses unattainable, the Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation stepped in to provide the technology recommended by his care team. With the glasses, Kyle can now read printed materials, navigate unfamiliar environments, and identify objects more independently. This support has reduced daily obstacles, strengthened his confidence, and restored a greater sense of control over his life.





SPREADING JOY AT THE HOLIDAYS

Each holiday season, the spirit of giving comes alive across Nascentia Health. Our staff look forward to this time of year with deep compassion, knowing how much the holidays can mean to the individuals and families we serve.

Annually, our care teams submit nominations for families facing significant need. From a long and thoughtful list, the Nascentia Health Charitable Foundation selected six families to support, reflecting both the depth of need in our community and the close relationships our staff build with those in their care. Through this program, families receive carefully chosen essentials and enrichment items, meeting immediate needs like safe sleeping arrangements, nutrition, and personal care, reflecting our commitment to responsible stewardship and meaningful support.

The generosity of our supporters makes this tradition possible. Staff members volunteer their time to shop, wrap, and deliver gifts, and our Pediatric team gathers each year to wrap gifts together, often in the home of one of our nurses turning compassion into action.


